

ORDINANCE 2025-25

AMENDING SECTION 34-77 OF CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF
NASHVILLE MAKING BUSINESSES ALLOWABLE APPLICANTS FOR STREET
AND SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS

WHEREAS, Article IV “Street and Special Event” in Chapter 34 “Streets, Sidewalks, and Other Public Places” does not include businesses as an allowable applicant for a Street and Special Event Permit, and

WHEREAS, several businesses have expressed interest in having events on Town property like the Nashville Junction stage and parking lot,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Nash County, North Carolina that Section 34-77 of the Town Code is hereby amended to include a business as an allowable applicant for Street and Special Event permit and shall read follows:

Sec. 34-77. - Activities covered.


This article applies to all street fairs, festivals, carnivals, parades, marches, rallies, demonstrations and other activities or public events that require the temporary closing or obstruction of all or a portion of any street or other public right-of-way or that substantially hinder or prevent the normal flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic along any street or other public right-of-way and special events on property owned or occupied by the town. Examples of special events include, but are not limited to, festivals, food truck rodeos, and concerts. Special events shall be considered only if sponsored by a local government, civic group, nonprofit organization, or **business**. Any such activity covered by this article shall hereafter be referred to as "the event."


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
