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Important Information:

- The Town will only grant a rollout cart exemption if there is no other resident at the applicant's address to tend to sanitation needs, and if the applicant has this form signed by a physician stating that the applicant is not physically able to tend to his/her sanitation needs. The Town has a right to verify this form with the physician. If the rollout cart exemption request is approved, the Town will provide garbage collection service in accordance with the following standards:
 - Collection will be once per week on Mondays, Tuesdays, or Wednesdays.
 - Garbage must be placed inside a 90-gallon rollout container.
 - The Town will approve the location of the container near the house.
 - The Town refuse collectors will roll the container to the truck, empty it, and return it to the location near the house.
- If the water & sewer disconnection exemption request is approved, you are still responsible for paying your bill by the due date to avoid late fees.
 - The Town reserves the right to temporarily interrupt water & sewer service to conduct emergency repairs.
